## FY-2017 Scheduled Work Program

### Drainage Program (2016-2017) *(October to December & February to mid-April)*

1. Matthews Rd – hill west of Batt Corner Rd
2. Batt Corner Rd – Hill north of Matthews Rd
3. Red Top Rd – Hill west of Tucker Rd
4. Additional pipe and drainage projects to-be-determined.

### Roadway Restoration Program

Restoration will be limited to the repair of spring breakup areas and other spot repairs of deteriorated pavement due to higher than usual freeze/thaw damage to the roadways.

1. Jacks Rd near Rudd Rd intersection.
2. Howe Rd east of HWY 95
3. Fern Ln east of HWY 95 and near Allendale Rd
4. Red Top Rd east of HWY 95 and near Van Slyke Rd
5. Allendale Rd north of Penny Ln to the dead end
6. Van Slyke Rd near Red Top Rd
7. Lon Ln and Pear Ln (west of Plum Rd) will receive a polymer sand seal, 1.25 miles

## FY-2017 Scheduled Work Program

### **Roadway Crack Sealing Program (all cracks ¼" and larger) (October to March)**

1. All Chip Seal Roads (25.05 miles)

### **Shoulder Maintenance (year around as work load permits)**

The Shoulder Maintenance program is planned to continue the work of rebuilding or reclaiming shoulders of the District's roadways. In 2014, we completed about 90 lane miles. In 2015, we completed about 55 lane miles. In 2016, we completed about 30 miles.

The 2017 forecast of 30 miles is as follows:

1. All Chip Seal Roads as needed.
2. Howe Rd – Bluff Ln toward Texas Rd.
3. Additional shoulder projects to-be-determined.

### **Right-of-Way Tree Trimming Maintenance (November to January)**

Tree trimming and general vegetation control will be limited in 2017 due historic snow plowing. Efforts will focus on sight distance and view triangles at intersections along with sign visibility as needed.

### **Pavement Marking Program (August to September) Approximately 610,000 lf of paint striping**

1. Red Top Rd – Hwy 95 to Stateline Rd
2. Homedale Rd – Hwy 95 to Beet Rd
3. Notus Rd – Hwy 19 to the Boise River Bridge
4. Ustick Rd – Fargo Rd to Beet Rd
5. Hoskins Rd – Hwy 55 to Agate Ln
6. Agate Ln – Homedale Rd to Hoskins Rd
7. Allendale Rd – Hoskins Rd to Peckham Rd
8. Batt Corner Rd – Hwy 95 to Ustick Rd
9. Fargo Rd – Ustick Rd to Peckham Rd
10. Peckham Rd – Notus Rd to Arena Valley Rd
11. Boise River Rd - Notus Rd to Ode Ln
12. Howe Rd – Notus Rd to Texas Rd
13. Dixie River Rd – Notus Rd to end of District

### **Bridge Maintenance (Recommended from Bridge Inspection Report) (February to mid-April)**

1. Travis Road (61e) – Replace wooden deck with concrete deck. (need engineering design)

### **Gravel Road Maintenance (include shoulder drainage)**

The District has 17.2 miles of gravel roads. All local roads are graded three times annually (spring, mid-summer & fall) with the subdivision roads graded twice annually. Grading includes shoulder and drainage work as needed. Gravel surfacing (3/4") will be placed every five to eight years or as needed.

## **Sign Maintenance Program**

All district signs will be inspected annually including a night time inspection to check the reflectivity of the signs. Any damage or faded signs will be replaced within 30 days.

In 2017 a Sign Upgrade Grant will fund \$20,360 in regulatory and warning sign and post upgrades to current standards. All roadways classified as Arterial, Major Collector and Minor Collector will have sign upgrades. Additionally, numerous curves will also receive improved warning signs.

## **Roadside Weed Spraying Program** *(October to November & mid-February to March)*

The planned program will include all roads in the District that do not have a "no spray permit". Subdivision's shoulders will be sprayed as weather permits. The program includes a minimum of 400 lane miles of noxious weed abatement application.
